

Introduction to Chemistry Education, 01:160:387
Eligibility and Advice for Registration
3/31/2016

Admission to Chem 387 is by invitation only. Invitations are sent out by the course coordinator in late March or early April.

To be eligible to take Chem 387, a student must

1. be a sophomore or above
2. have met one of two grade requirements:
 - a. Earned a top score in the first AND the second semester of General Chemistry* OR
 - b. placed out of the first semester of General Chemistry with an AP score of 4 or 5 and received a top score in the second semester of General Chemistry
3. have a strong overall academic performance as indicated by overall GPA, GPA in courses required for the major, and grades in courses with a pedagogical component.
4. be a part of the Certificate in Chemistry Education program. This requirement may be waived for students on a case-by-case basis.

Chemistry 387 is not open to students in the School of Pharmacy

*General Chemistry refers to either 159/160, 161/162, 163/164 or approved combinations of them.

Registration for 387

To be considered for Chem 387, students need take no action themselves. In March or April, the coordinator for the Certificate in Chemistry Education (CCE) Program will send out invitations to students who have met the eligibility requirements. The invitation includes directions to fill out an application online, as well as a description of the program itself. There will be a deadline for the applications, and interviews will follow. Once accepted, the student will receive a special permission number during the summer that will allow registration.
